Position Title: Middle School Math Teacher (Christian School 6th-8th grade)

**Salary is 10 months (\$31,000-\$68,000 Full-Time range) 7:30am-3:00pm
Monday - Friday. Full-Time or Part-Time**

Reporting To: Middle School Principal

Job Purpose: We are seeking a passionate and engaging educator to provide effective mathematics instruction in Math 6, Pre-Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra 1(HS), fostering strong foundational skills and building student confidence in math. This role supports a range of learners by providing appropriate challenge for advanced students while offering targeted intervention to ensure all students achieve academic growth.

The ideal candidate is someone who takes pride in their work and contributes positively to the overall school community. We are looking for individuals with a strong Christian faith and alignment with our mission, who value service and stewardship in their daily responsibilities. Successful candidates will be relational, structured, and engaging, with the ability to work both independently and as part of a team.

This position requires flexibility in a growing school environment, a willingness to support evolving needs, and a professional commitment to excellence, student development, and continuous improvement.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work with Middle School Principal to teach, support students in Math courses. Mentor students to develop their Christian faith and support both language and spiritual development.
- Teach Math 6, Pre-Algebra, Geometry (MS) and Algebra 1 (HS)
- Build strong foundational skills and math confidence
- Maintain regular office hours, to be reachable by students and teaching adult, as scheduled. This may include in-person or online meetings;

- Effectively communicate with teachers and administrators. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Calling and or emailing teacher as needed;
 - Returning phone calls/emails ASAP but no longer than 24 hours after initial contact;
- Collaborate with other instructional teachers in the same content area;
- Support students in their Christian faith by attending mission trips/retreats and disciple students in Christianity:
 - A required condition of employment every staff member attends the all school retreat and at least one off campus school-sponsored mission trip (YWAM, Dream Center, etc) as needed per academic year and receives a stipend of 4 hours a night at \$25 an hour for any overnight trip.
- Other duties as assigned.

Educations and/or Experience/Qualifications:

- California teaching credential in Math, required (willing to pursue)
- Degree (B.A./B.M.) in field of instruction, required
- Experience working with middle or high school students preferred
- 1-3 years of successful teaching experience, preferred.

Physical Job Requirements:

This position is primarily performed in a classroom setting. While carrying out the duties of this role, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, and engage with students. The teacher frequently uses hands and fingers to operate a computer, write, and handle instructional materials. The role also requires the ability to communicate clearly, including talking and hearing, to effectively deliver instruction and interact with students, parents, and colleagues.
