Position Title: HS Chemistry and Math Teacher (Christian School 9th-12th grade) (With ability to support lower-level math preferred) Part-time/Full-time

Salary is 10 Months (\$31,000-\$68,000 range). 7:30 am to 3:00 pm Monday-Friday.

Reporting To: Academic Dean and Dept. Chair

Job Purpose: Teach high school Chemistry and math, including college-preparatory and/or honors Chemistry. Use Harkness and best instructional practices to promote inquiry and collaboration, with an emphasis on hands-on, lab-based learning. Ability to support foundational math, Algebra I and Geometry preferred. Participate in school community events, including mission trips, retreats, meetings, and open house programs.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach chemistry and math courses for high school including Foundational math, Algebra 1, Geometry, and Chemistry.
- Continue and build a biblically-centered science and math program at the school to help students progress to advanced levels
- Strong instructional skills would be required with details and follow-up with students and parents.
- Support students in their Christian faith by attending mission tript/retreats and disciple students in Christianity.
- Maintain regular office hours, to be reachable by students or parents; All communications should be responded to within 24 hours to ensure alignment and that all parties remain informed.
- Collaborate with other instructional teachers in the same content area;
- Attending all online and in-person meetings as scheduled;
- Other duties as assigned.
