Position Title: Middle School History Teacher (Christian School 6th-8th grade) Part-time/Full-time

Salary is 10 Months (\$31,000-\$68,000 range). 7:30 am to 3:00 pm Monday-Friday.

Reporting To: Middle School Principal

Job Purpose: The History Teacher is responsible for delivering engaging instruction in World History, U.S. History, fostering critical thinking, meaningful discussion, and strong writing skills. This role brings both historical content to life through dynamic lessons, interactive projects, and a relational classroom approach that encourages students to connect faith and learning.

The ideal candidate demonstrates a strong Christian faith and alignment with the school's mission, creating a structured, supportive, and engaging learning environment. As a collaborative team member in a growing school community, the teacher remains flexible and committed to student development, academic excellence, and continuous professional improvement.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach middle School World History, and U.S. History using engaging and developmentally appropriate instructional methods
- Emphasize critical thinking, discussion, and writing.
- Integrate biblical principles and a Christian worldview across history instruction.
- Develop and implement interactive projects and activities that bring historical content to life
- Maintain effective and timely communication with teachers, administrators, and families, as appropriate. This includes, but is not limited to, initiating and responding to phone calls and emails as needed. All communications
